

**Every voter** (already registered to vote who presents themselves to the polling location of the precinct where they are properly registered to vote) **MUST** present **ONE** of the following forms of identification in order to be allow to cast a ballot in any election in South Carolina:

Acceptable identification includes:

**Valid SC Driver's License (now includes Concealed Weapons Permit)**

**SC Identification Card issued by the SC Department of Revenue – DMV**

**Federal Military Identification card**

**United States Passport**

**SC Voter Registration card WITH PICTURE**

(this is available at County Voter Registration office)

To be used for voting, identification **MUST** be current (not expired) with picture of voter.

There are exceptions for a properly registered voters who **CANNOT** get one of the above "Photo IDs". Ask the poll worker in your voting precinct. You **MUST** have your voter registration card in order to vote using the 'exception'.
