


# SALUDA RIVER PADDLING GUIDE



## RIVERVIEW TAVERN ACCESS TO MASSENGALE ACCESS

**Topo Map**      Greenville  
**County**        Greenville, Pickens, Anderson  
**Reach**          SC 124 to SC 81 (Anderson Road)

**Put In @ the Riverview Tavern Access**----- From the intersection of Anderson Road (SC 81) and White Horse Road (US 25 Bypass) travel north on US 25 Bypass 1.4 miles and exit onto SC 123 South, at 3.9 miles cross the Saluda River and immediately thereafter turn right onto North Fishtrap Road, at 4.2 miles turn right onto SC 124, and at 4.9 miles the Riverview Tavern will be on the right just before crossing the river again. The put in and parking areas are located to the left side of the Tavern adjacent to and below the bridge. This is private property with the put in provided by the Tavern owner. Please observe it as such and patronize the Tavern, if possible.



**Difficulties/Landmarks\***      Just upstream of the put in is a class 2 ledge. Several other shoals, eddies, and riffles are located in this area. Half mile downstream from the SC 124 Bridge there is a large junkyard located on river right where a small ledge is located. At 0.6 miles is located another small ledge, which forms a small surfing wave, adjacent to the Riverview Subdivision. At 0.9 miles is located the SC 123 Bridge, and at 2 miles is located a WCRSA treatment facility, soon to be decommissioned. Old Easley Bridge Road Bridge is located at 2.2 miles and at 2.7 miles WCRSA is building a replacement treatment plant near Georges Creek. There are several other small shoals along this reach and at a little over 5 miles Old Anderson and Anderson Roads will appear. Both riverbanks are private property for the majority of the reach.

**Take Out @ the Massengale Access**----- From the intersection of Anderson Road (SC 81) and White Horse Road (US 25 Bypass) travel west on SC 81 1.9 miles, then turn right onto Old Dunham Bridge Road (S-23-327) at the Riverwood Plaza Shopping Center, 75 yards later turn left into the shopping center. The take out site and parking are located adjacent to the river and SC 81 in the gravel lot. This is private property where permission has been granted for access, so observe it as such.

\* Rain, drought, and dam releases may greatly influence river flow.
