Residents of Mauldin and Fountain Inn should contact their local mosquito control agent. • All spraying on private property is by request only. • Residents who requested service will be notified of completion via post card.

*****Greenville County does not spray privately owned bodies of water. This includes private ponds and HOA retention areas and ponds.*****

Mosquito Prevention Tips

Eliminate Standing Water

All mosquitoes require water in which to breed. Even the smallest of containers that can collect water can breed hundreds to thousands of mosquitoes. They don't need much water to lay their eggs. Be sure to drain any standing water around your house. Action items include:

- ✦ Dispose of any tires. Tires can breed thousands of mosquitoes.
- ✦ Clean pet water dishes regularly.
- ✦ Check and empty children's toys.
- ✦ Repair leaky outdoor faucets.
- ✦ Change the water in bird baths at least once a week.
- ✦ Don't leave empty bottles or cans outside
- ✦ Clear roof gutters of debris.
- ✦ Canoes & other boats should be turned over.
- ✦ Avoid water collecting on pool covers.
- ✦ Empty water collected in tarps around the yard or on woodpiles.
- ✦ Work with your HOA or property owners group.
